NYLT Participant's Equipment List

Class "A" Uniform

- Scouting America Field Uniform (Beige/Green/Blue)
- · Scout shirt with proper insignia
- NYLT Official Cap (received at course)
- Boots/Closed Shoes
- Scout Shorts/Pants
- Scout Socks
- Watch
- Water Bottle/Water Source
- Scout Belt (web/leather with Scout Buckle)
- Participant's Notebook (receive at course)
- Pens/Pencils

Class "B" Uniform

(Only difference between Class A & B is type of shirt)

- NYLT T-Shirt (Received at course & ordered during on-line registration). Additional t-shirts available for purchase on day of registration.
- Mandatory Required Forms for Registration
 - o NYLT Code of Conduct (signed by all)
 - Medical Form Parts A, B & C, Signature by doctor & copy of insurance card.
 - (camp copy on file does not count!)
 - NYLT NEEDS <u>TWO HARD COPIES</u> OF MEDICAL FORMS

Dress for the course is the official Scout uniform, old or new style: Short sleeve Scout Uniform shirt, Troop, Venturing or Ship shorts, Scout Socks, Scout Belt and Scout Buckle, NYLT Cap (received at course); long pants are not recommended in the heat. Class "B" shirt is provided at course.

A complete uniform is required from Check-In until Graduation!

Footgear: Suitable for the woods and short hikes plus a change if desired (boots suggested – well broken-in). No sandals, crocs or open toe shoes.

Raingear: Be prepared for all kinds of weather – the program doesn't stop.

Outerwear: Jacket or sweater, Appropriate to the season.

<u>Underwear:</u> Enough for the entire course including Scout Socks.

Sleepwear: Appropriate to the season.

Hygiene: Soap, shampoo, towel, washcloth, toothpaste, toothbrush, comb/brush, mirror, shower shoes.

<u>Personal Gear:</u> pen/pencil, notepad, flashlight, batteries, watch, sunscreen, bug spray. **A water bottle/canteen is required.**

Camping Gear: BACKPACK ONLY (No trunks, laundry Baskets, Suitcases (rolling or other), No Trash Bags!) a single person tent (no sharing), ground cloth, sleeping bag, pad, pillow.

Chair: Light weight, folding, portable to carry.

Optional: Disposable camera or musical instrument

- All items should be clearly marked with the Participant's name and unit number.
- All prescription medications must be in original containers and should be given to the designated Course Director or Medical Officer upon arrival.
- Cell Phones are permitted only as a tool and used only when directed by NYLT Staff.
 If used other than when approved, it will be confiscated and returned at the end of the course session. Be aware that no charging stations are available while at camp.
